## District Collector Jitesh V Patil inspected the greenery

Bhadradi Kothagudem, July 31, TSIT :On Wednesday, District Collector Jitesh V Patil along with Additional Collector of Local Bodies Vidyachandana inspected the model Anganwadi toilets of Lakshmi Devi Palli Mandal Prashanthi Nagar Gram Panchayat, the green spaces set up in Regalla and Baoji Nagar Tandas. First, under the employment guarantee scheme in Lakshmi Devi Palli Mandal Prashanthi Nagar Gram Panchayat, they inspected the model toilets constructed for the use of children and pregnant women in Anganwadi school and expressed their satisfaction. After that, as part of Vanamahotsavam, the greenery in Regalla and Baoji Tandas was inspected.



Speaking on the occasion, he said that the Vanamahotsavam program is being organized by the state government and the main purpose of this program is to increase forests in the state. As part of this programme, 6000 saplings have been planted in the vacant 12-acre forest area of Regalla village through the employment guarantee scheme, he said. Among the plants planted are amla, chinta, neredu, neem, copper, vela-

ga, custard apple, mango and other plants, he said. The authorities have been advised to plant the plantation in such a way that there is an average distance between the plants, one big plant next to another small plant. He instructed the local officials to make appropriate arrangements that next Wednesday morning at 6:30 am I will come along with the youth of the village and we will plant the plants together. It is suggested that

a water pond should be set up experimentally in each village panchayat through the employment guarantee scheme and Ajolla pumping should be carried out.

Later visited Munaga plantation in Mylaram village. On this occasion, he said that through NRGs, all kinds of incentives and subsidies will be provided to those who are planting tuber crops. He added that farmers can grow economically by growing crop wise instead of depending on one crop. MPDO Lakshmi Devi Palli, MP O, Assistant Engineer, APO EGS, Gram Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat staff, Employment Guarantee Scheme staff and others participated in this programme.

## T'gana Legislative Assembly adjourned till today

Hyderabad: The Telangana Legislative Assembly was adjourned till Thursday. Assembly Speaker Gaddam Prasad Kumar adjourned the house after the Appropriation Bill 2024-25 was passed. Earlier, during the debate on the Appropriation Bill, heated arguments were witnessed between the ruling Congress and opposition members.

## Telangana Congress MP urges PM Modi to expedite the amendment of PCA Act

Hyderabad: Telangana Congress MP Porika Balram Naik on Wednesday urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to take necessary steps to amend the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (PCA) Act, 1960. In his letter to Modi, Naik, elected from Mahabubabad Lok Sabha constituency, emphasized the urgent need to table the new animal welfare bill (Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Bill 2022) in the current session of the Parliament to ensure a safe and humane society for both humans and animals. He also outlined the need to increase the



penalty for crimes against animals. Currently, the maximum fine for even the most heinous crime against animals—including beating, poisoning, raping or burning an animal—is a mere Rs. 50 (and Rs. 100 for repeat offenders). In a statement, Mousumi Gupta, Director of Government Affairs, Humane Society International/India (HIS) said: "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act,

1960, is outdated and inadequate in addressing the severity of crimes against animals. It's disheartening to see that even the most heinous acts of cruelty carry minimal penalties. The time for change is now, and we are grateful for the support of the MPs who recognize the urgent need for stronger animal protection laws". "The proposed amendments to the PCA Act are a vital step towards ensuring justice and safety for animals across the country. We urge the government to act swiftly and table the amendment bill in the current session of Parliament," she said.

## Heavy rain likely in Telangana on Aug 1: Met

Hyderabad: Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places in Adilabad, Komaram Bheem Asifabad, Mancherial, Nirmal, Mulugu, Bhadradi Kothagudem, Khammam, Medak, Kamareddy districts of Telangana on Thursday, the Meteorological Centre said on Wednesday. In a daily weather report here, it said that thunder-

## Bellampally Singareni Area Hospital Must Go on Strike Against Closure Measures: JAC Warning of Labor Unions to Singareni



Bellampally, July 31, TSIT: The Bellampally Singareni Area Hospital Protection Committee has issued a stern warning that if the management does not halt the closure of the Bellampally Singareni Area Hospital, they will go on strike in the Bellampally area. This declaration came during a gate meeting held on Wednesday in the premises of Shantikhandi coal mine in Bellampally town. Key leaders from the conservation committee, including President T Maniramsingh, Vice Presidents Siddamsetty Rajamouli, and MD Chand Pasha, addressed the meeting. They emphasized the critical importance of the hospital, which, alongside five dispensaries in Bellampally and Kothagudem (the main center of Singareni), comprises a 250-bed facility with 50 doctors and 200 medical staff. The leaders alleged that the Bellampally GM had been deliberately taking steps to close down the Bellampally

area hospital. They accused the management of systematically shutting down wards by not appointing medical experts and staff, even converting the emergency department into a general ward. They asserted that appointing adequate medical personnel would ensure comprehensive medical services for thousands of workers and their families. The protection committee emphasized that if their demands are not met, they will intensify their struggle, bringing the issue to the attention of the C&MD and the Chief Minister of the state. The leaders vowed to continue their fight until a solution is reached. Among the participants in the meeting were Ailalah, MD Ojjar, MD Chand Pasha, T Mani Ram Singh, A Mahender, Neerati Rajanna, Gogarla Shankar, and Pocha Mallu.
